They have both been invaluable in our team and I know that they will be missed by residents, staff and families alike.










## Mākslas grupiņa/ART Therapy group

Katrs pieliek savu roku un izdomu un gala rezultāts visus patīkami pārsteidz.




### \*\*\*\*\* Happy Hour/ Laimīgā stunda \*\* \*\* \* \* \* \* \*
